The Higher Education Emergency Relief Funding II (HEERF II) was passed by law in Dec. 2020 through The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA Act). HEERF II Funds provide direct emergency assistance to support students' cost of attendance for emergency cost that arise due to coronavirus such as tuition, food, housing, health care and/or child care. Students DO NOT need to apply for the HEERF II grant. Grants at Cox College were awarded as follows.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS PRIORITY GROUP ONE

According to HEERF II funding eligibility requirements, and other stipulations, a recipient were prioritized by exceptional need. (Spring 2021 enrolled students receiving a Pell Grant were automatically funded)

Priority Group One - Pell eligible students that meet the criteria below as of March 24, 2021.

- Student must have a 2020-21 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) received and on file at Cox College.
- Student must be enrolled in at least 1 Credit hour in the Spring 2021 semester.
- Students with an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of 5712 or less.

## Awarding Procedure -

- 224 Pell recipients received \$800.00 total \$179,200.00
- 77 Undergraduate or Graduate students not receiving Pell with an EFC of 0 received \$600.00 total \$46,200.00
- 46 Undergraduate students only with an EFC less than 5712 to 1 received \$335.00 total \$15,410.00
- 27 Graduate students with an EFC less than 3001 received \$200.00 total \$5,400.00
