

Sonography programs (General/Vascular and Echo)

Cox College's Bachelor of Science in Diagnostic Imaging Sonography program and Post-Baccalaureate in Echocardiography program qualifies students to sit for American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS) certification exams. ARDMS is the minimum requirement to practice sonography in most states. Some states may have additional licensing requirements, provided [here](#).

Licensing requirements vary by state/territory and relocating could impact whether you will meet eligibility requirements for licensure. Employers, state licensing agencies, and federal regulators all consider an ARDMS credential to be verification that the graduate met rigorous professional standards. Currently, the state of Missouri does not have additional licensing requirements.

ARRT is the minimum requirement to practice as a registered technologist in CT/MRI/IR in most states. Some states may have additional licensing requirements, provided [here](#).
