- 2. Completed course requirements to apply:
  - a. Completion of Intermediate Algebra (or higher) or prove math proficiency. Proficiency met with a 22 or higher on Math portion of ACT, or 70% or higher on Math portion of TEAS.

- **b.** All general education courses listed in red box below **must be completed** by start of the nursing program.
- 3. GPA Requirements:
  - a. A minimum of **3.0 cumulative GPA is required to apply**.
  - b. A minimum of **2.5 cumulative GPA for science courses completed**.
- 4. Applicants may be interviewed based on the recommendation of the faculty and the ASN Nursing Department Chair.
