FAST TRACK Program Application Requirements

- 1. Complete the application requirements listed on the front page and be admitted to Cox College
- 2. Completed Course Requirements to apply:
 - a. Completion of Intermediate Algebra (or higher) or prove math proficiency. Proficiency met with a 22 or higher on Math portion of ACT or 80% or higher on Math portion of TEAS.
 - b. All general education courses listed in green box below **must** be completed **prior** to start of nursing program
- 3. GPA Requirements:
 - a. A minimum of 3.2 cumulative GPA is required to apply.
 - b. A minimum of **2.5 cumulative GPA for science courses**: Human Anatomy, Human Physiology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Pathophysiology
- 4. Applicants may be interviewed based on the recommendation of the faculty and the BSN Nursing Department Chair.

Benefits of the BSN Program

- The BSN program encompasses all of the course work taught in the ASN program, plus a more in-depth treatment of the physical and social sciences, nursing research, public and community health, nursing management, and the humanities.
- State-of-the-art simulation center located on campus that offers "real-life" situations where students can practice in a controlled environment.
- Three step approach to learning: lecture, skills training, and hands-on clinical practice within CoxHealth.
- Program length: Upon compeletion of prerequisites the program is 16 months.
