Program Application Requirements

- 1. Complete the application requirements listed on the front page and be admitted to Cox College
- 2. Completed Course Requirements to apply:
 - a. Completion of Intermediate Algebra (or higher) or prove math proficiency. Proficiency met with a 22 or higher on Math portion of ACT or 70% or higher on Math portion of TEAS.
 - b. A minimum of 37 credit hours must be completed. All general education courses listed in red box below **must be completed** by start of the nursing program.
- 3. GPA Requirements:
 - a. A minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA is required to apply.
 - b. A minimum of **2.5 cumulative GPA for science courses**: Human Anatomy, Human Physiology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Pathophysiology.
- 4. Applicants may be interviewed based on the recommendation of the faculty and the BSN Nursing Department Chair.
