

Undergraduate Nursing Department Admissions Process
Program Selection Criteria

Application Process

1. Student will submit college application with all official transcripts
2. Student will submit program application
3. Student will schedule through ATI to take the TEAS entrance exam
4. Student may be interviewed as requested by the UND Chair and Faculty

Application Deadline

1. Applicants seeking fall entry into the nursing programs must apply by March 1.
2. Applicants seeking spring entry into the nursing programs must apply by September 1.

Applicants applying after the deadline may be considered for admission based on space availability.

1. TEAS Exam

Total Exam Score	Points
80% and above	40 Points
60%-79%	30 Points
59% and below	0 Points

2. Cumulative GPA (figured on required courses completed)

Cumulative GPA x 10 = GPA points (maximum of 40 points)

3. Cumulative Science GPA (figured on required courses completed)

Cumulative GPA x 10 = GPA points (maximum of 40 points)

Maximum points = 120 points

The UND faculty will rank applicants based on the above formula.
